1. Bristol De Mai Held his own with top chasers in recent seasons, winning the Betfair Chase three times. 	2. Chris's Dream Capable of very good performances. Ran The Storyteller close at Down Royal. 	3. Yala Enki Stamina will not be an issue given his exploits in Welsh Grand Nationals. Needs soft ground. 	4. Ballyoptic It appears his best days are behind him. Was going well in this two years ago but fell four from home. 
5. Definitely Red Long seen by his trainer as an ideal type for this race but it's a big ask for a 12-year-old horse. 	6. Lake View Lad Began the season with a win over Santini on the Mildmay Course, but well beaten the last twice. 	7. Burrows Saint Won the Irish National two years ago and has been trained for this ever since then. 	8. Magic Of Light Gave Tiger Roll plenty to think about two years ago when a fine second. Has good course form. 
9. Acapella Bourgeois Beat Burrows Saint giving him weight in the Bobbyjo and now enjoys a nice swing in the weights. 	10. Talkischeap Looked promising when winning the bet365 Gold Cup at Sandown two years ago, but hit by injuries. 	11. Tout Est Permis Not disgraced in the highest grade earlier this season, but has not progressed as hoped. 	12. Anibale Fly Has placed in two Gold Cups and fourth and fifth in this down the years... but that was a while ago. 
13. Mister Malarky A smart novice a few years back who is hard to predict, but at his best is capable of some very smart form. 	14. Kimberlite Candy Has been one to watch after finishing second over fences in December 2019. Has good stamina. 	15. Any Second Now Won a Grade Two over two miles last time, but has won a Kim Muir in the past. Obvious chance. 	16. Balko Des Flos Won the Ryanair Chase in 2018, but has been a long way below his best form this season. 
17. Alpha des Obeaux Had shown nothing all season before a fair fourth in the Cheltenham cross country to Tiger Roll. 	18. OK Corral Had last year's race taken place he would have been among the leading contenders. 	19. Takingrisks Has won three major staying handicap chases, including the Scottish National. 	20. Shattered Love Smart mare at her best, and she not far off that at Cheltenham when third to Colreevy and Eilamay. 
21. Jett Was quietly fancied for this last year, but has not been in the same sort of form this time around. 	22. Lord Du Mesnil Has made a real name for himself at Haydock in recent seasons, but far from a one-track wonder. 	23. Potters Corner Welsh National winner with limitless stamina. However, he needs it soft to slow the others. 	24. Class Conti Has been running with credit in some of Ireland's biggest handicaps. Needs to find best form. 
25. Milan Native A winner at Cheltenham last season, he was fancied to run well there again last month but disappointed. 	26. Discorama Somehow has only won twice in an 18-race career, but his ability is not in doubt. Has proven stamina. 	27. Vieux Lion Rouge Has run in this four times and the Becher five times, winning that twice. 	28. Cloth Cap Impressive winner of the Ladbrokes Trophy. Jumps, stays and 14lb well in. 
29. Cabaret Queen Has won the Munster and Kerry Nationals, but they are a long way removed from the real thing. 	30. Minellacelebration Won two nice prizes at Uttoxeter and Aintree either side of a summer break, but struggled since. 	31. Canelo Struck off a 12lb higher mark at Wetherby than his win over the Mildmay fences in October. 	32. The Long Mile One of the most unexposed runners in the field. Not without a squeak here. 
33. Give Me A Copper Owned by Sir Alex Ferguson, among others, and has sometimes given connections something to cheer. 	34. Farclas Won the Triumph Hurdle in 2018 and on best form he is well handicapped. Lacks experience over fences. 	35. Minella Times Has been all the rage for this in recent weeks, but has to prove his stamina. 	36. Sub Lieutenant Once a classy operator for Henry de Bromhead, for whom he was second in a Topham over these fences. 
37. Hogan's Height A winner over these fences in the Grand Sefton. Lightly raced since having shot up the weights. 	38. Double Shuffle Talented horse who was second in the King George in 2017. Excels at Kempton over three miles. 	39. Ami Desbois Caught by Double Shuffle at Kempton in January and ran a solid race last time out. 	40. Blaktion Favourite for the 2018 National, but brought down at the first. Nothing has gone right since. 
Res 1. Some Neck Won over the Cheltenham cross-country fences in December and a fair third to Tiger Roll in March. 	Res 2. Secret Reprive Lightly-raced seven-year-old who will surely never have a better chance. Won the Welsh National. 	Res 3. Kauto Riko From the family of the legendary Kauto Star and has done his bit to uphold family honour. 	Res 4. Fagan Albert Bartlett second in 2016, but has had three long absences since then. Won last time out.
